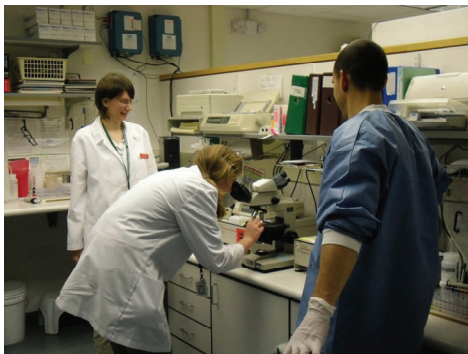

NEW VISION HEALTH CAREERS

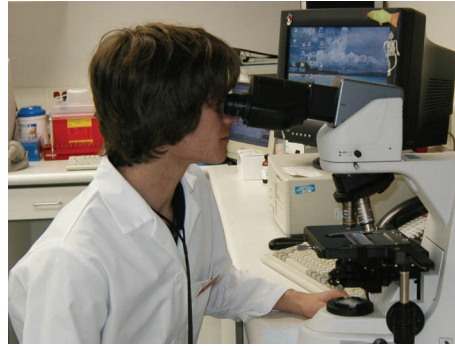
