



## Home Schooled Students



The difference between Home schooled and Home Bound:

**Home Schooled** – Parents moved student out of school for instruction in the home.

**Homebound** – School district places the student at home due to medical issues (physical, mental, or emotional) and must have a Doctor's note.



How to enroll home schooled students who come in to take assessments:

- **0011** with the location of Home schooled (0888 location code for most districts).

**DO NOT USE THE WALK IN ENROLLMENT CODE “5555” ANYMORE!!!**

When to enroll home schooled students who come in to take assessments:

You have three choices. You may:

- Enroll them at the beginning of the year and leave them enrolled all year.
- Enroll them at the beginning of the testing period and leave them enrolled.
- Enroll them on the day they take the test and exit them the day after with a 255 code (Transfer to home-schooling by parent or guardian) for each test.

Anyway you choose to enroll these students, they **WILL NOT** be considered for accountability as long as you use the home schooled location code.



\*\*\*\*Home schooled students receiving special ed services (5905 enrollment code) do not need the 0011 as their existing enrollment code covers them.
