If applying for a summer help program students must have a working knowledge of:

- Basic knowledge of lawn care equipment, operating, safety, and maintenance.
- An understanding of electrical wiring and safety procedures involved.
- Basic knowledge in building trades (framing, sheeting, and running equipment to do so.
- General understanding of plumbing and where to find problems.
- Ability to work in inclement weather (we are outside often on not so nice days).
- Ability to work at a laborer's pace for an eight hour shift. This includes digging, moving building materials, moving heavy bagged material etc.
- Employee must be punctual and be able to fulfill a forty hour work week.
