### **BOCES Operations**

At the urging of several staff in informal conversation the BOCES Operations segment of the New and Notes will be a regular feature to highlight aspects of BOCES operations. In this first segment we outline the four main divisions in our organization. They include: Instructional Programs, Instructional Support Services, Management Services and District Superintendent Services.

**Instructional Programs** include all services that we provide in which our staff offer direct instruction or related services that support direct instruction.

**Instructional Support Services** includes all services that we provide to districts in the area of professional development, program development and planning.

**Management Services** includes services that generally do not involve instruction such as business office services, food service management and printing.

**District Superintendent Services** includes services to component districts such as functioning as a liaison between NYSED and the field, assisting boards with superintendent searches, regional consultation and coordination.

### **Election of Board members**
