Rotary Partners with FEH BOCES

Malone Rotary has reached out to forge a partnership with FEH BOCES. This partnership includes the following elements:

- Inclusion of NFEC in the Rotary Teacher of the Year Program.
- A \$500 scholarship for an adult enrolled in a CTE program (Beginning September 2015, application details available soon).
- Purchase of materials to support NFEC Building Trades project to roof a gazebo at the Malone Recreation Park in the Fall of 2015.
- Offer by Rotary to have one or more members sit on the General CTE Advisory Committee being formed for the 2015-16 school year.
