The School Library System recently provided 78 brand new toddler/children's books to the Early Childhood Education program at NFEC. The School Library System is also providing access to the Exploring Nature k-12 science database that is aligned to the Next Generation Science Standards and the World Book eBook Suite that offers over 1,000 eBooks. The World Book arrangement allows unlimited, simultaneous use of informational, non-fiction eBooks for grades k-12, as well as, hundreds of classics in eBook format to all students and teachers in FEH BOCES operated programs. NCCC Staff Meet with BRIDGE Students

A North Country Community College representative presented information regarding the BRIDGE program for 16 students at NFEC on Thursday, September 24. The meeting took place in the computer lab on Sept 24th allowing students to register for the program on-line. New Vision Law and Government students receive college credit for ENG 101, POS 101, ENG 105, POS 102. New Vision Health students can receive college credit for ENG 101, HED 101, POS 102 and PSY 138. The students receive a steep discount paying only \$60/course vs. the usual fee of \$540 per course. FEH BOCES has a long history of partnering with North Country Community College on a number of educational programs.
