### **Capital Project Update**

Currently Component Boards are being asked to enter into a Joint (Intermunicipal) Agreement. It is anticipated that all ten Board will have voted by early to mid-June. All Boards that have voted to date are in favor of the Joint Agreement approach to the project.

By mid-June a FEH BOCES Capital Project brochure will be available for distribution as outreach begins ahead of the public vote on September 21.

On June 6, three firms interested in serving as Construction Managers for the project will be interviewed. Selection of a Construction Manager is expected at the June 15 FEH Board meeting.

In July the FEH Board will take several required actions to formally adopt the referendum to be placed before the voters and to approve the logistics required for a region-wide vote.
